BBC and the abolition of the use of animals in science

As announced in the January newsletter 54, the Board of Directors of the Belgian Brain Council has given its support to the initiative led by the European Brain Research: Animal Research and "**Pledge for Science**".

In essence, and in response to the European initiative "Save cruelty-free cosmetics - Commit to a Europe without animal testing" which aims at "phasing out the use of animals in science", the brain trust wishes to moderate these demands: a total ban on the use of animals in biomedical research is premature. To raise these concerns, the EBC has issued a statement on animal research for Brain Awareness Week 2023. BBC and the 9th Academy of National Brain Councils

This year, the 9th NBC Academy will be held over two days: Tuesday 23 and Wednesday 24 May 2023. The 23rd of May will be dedicated to the "Pledge for Science" (see point 2) where NBC delegates will be invited to meet MEPs from their country. The meetings with MEPs are organised by the EBC (for more information please contact Eleonora Varntoumian, the new Communications and Policy Officer, policy@braincouncil.eu). The day will end with a reception at the European Parliament in Brussels.

On 24 May, the morning will be devoted to meetings between each NBC delegate and the respective health attachés of their permanent representation. These meetings are organised by the EBC. In the afternoon, the session of the Academy will take place at the University Foundation. This meeting will be held in pre-taped and online.

Belgian Brain Plan

The continuation of phase 1 of the Belgian Brain Plan, financially supported by eight pharmaceutical companies (BMS, EISAI, IPSEN, JANSSEN, LUNDBECK, MERCK, PFIZER and UCB), focused on the state of the art of such a plan with as a key point a national registry of brain diseases, was marked by an important 3-hour meeting held on 17 March at the University Foundation bringing together the BBC's Belgian Brain Plan task force, the federal deputy, Dr. Daniel Bacquelaine, academics from UMons and ULB, representatives of the LUSS and the VPP, the pharmaceutical industry (Janssen, Pfizer and UCB), and the policy advisor of the EBC. The meeting was moderated by Prof. Grégory Lewkowitz, Director of the Smart Law Hub and researcher at the Institute of Artificial Intelligence for the Common Good (FARI) in Brussels. Professor Lewkowitz was accompanied by 3 data scientists. The meeting allowed for active participation of the participants. The results of this meeting will be presented by Prof. Lewkowitz at the GA on 23 May. Further action will be submitted to the GA on 23 May for approval.
