

General assembly and Belgian Brain Data Hub

The General Meeting on 23 May provided an opportunity to present the continuation of phase 1 of the Belgian Brain Plan to members and invited partners. This was contextualised by the 2 guest speakers, Mr Nick Marly, adviser to the cabinet of the Federal Minister for Health, Mr Frank Vandenbroucke, and Professor Grégory Lewkowicz, Director of the Smart Law Hub, ULB.

BBC and the abolition of the use of animals in science

Along with 48 other associations, the BBC supported the European Brain Council in its commitment to science: "Brain research and innovation in the EU in response to recent political developments". This support was echoed among our members, many of whom signed the individual letter of support. To date (12 June 2023), 3,337 people have signed the letter.


The current Secretary General, Roland Pochet, has obtained accreditation for access to the European Parliament.
